

EARLY VOTING INFORMATION GENERAL ELECTION, NOVEMBER 6, 2018

EARLY VOTING:

- A) **First day to accept early voting ballot request:** July 8, 2018
120 days prior to an election (§32-941)
- B) **First day to mail early voting ballots to voters:** October 1, 2018
35 days before election (§32-808)
- C) **First day to vote in person at the Clerk's Office:** October 9, 2018
30 days before election (§32-942)
- D) **Deadline to apply for ballot by mail if person is not a registered voter:**
October 19, 2018
Third Friday preceding an election (§32-941, §32-945)
- E) **Deadline to apply for ballot by mail:** October 26, 2018, 6:00 P.M.
Second Friday preceding the election (§32-941)
- F) **Deadline to vote in person at the Clerk's office:** November 5, 2018
Monday before the election (§32-942)
- G) **Deadline for agent to pick up ballot:** November 6, 2018, 7:00 P.M.
One hour before closing of the polls on Election Day (§32-943)
- H) **Deadline for agent to return voted ballot:** November 6, 2018, 8:00 P.M.
No later than closing of the polls on Election Day (§32-950)
- I) **Deadline for voted ballot to be returned by mail:** November 6, 2018, 8:00 P.M.
No later than closing of the polls on Election Day (§32-950)

APPLICATION FOR EARLY VOTING:

- A) Application must be in writing and shall indicate voter's residence address, the address to which the ballot should be mailed if different, and telephone number. (§32-941)
- B) Application must be signed by voter or voter's agent (§32-941)
- C) Agent can apply for a ballot and/or pick up a ballot for another person (§32-943)
- D) No person serving on a campaign committee shall act as an agent, unless such person is a member of the registered voters family (§32-943)
- E) No person shall act as agent for more than two voters for any election. (§32-943)
- F) A voter registration application will be included with the ballot if the voter is not registered; however, a registration application cannot be mailed after October 19, 2018 (§32-941)
